

The County tops up local municipal CIP funding for projects that align with our goals.

County CIP Goals:

Study Grant

- 100% of costs to a maximum of \$10,000 per study, and a maximum of 2 study grants per project
- Eligible studies include:
 - i) Urban design studies and architectural/design drawings;
 - ii) Heritage impact assessments;
 - iii) Concept plans and site plans;
 - iv) Structural analyses and evaluation of existing and proposed mechanical, electrical, and other building systems;
 - v) Energy efficiency and water conservation studies;
 - vi) Geothermal energy design studies;
 - vii) Blue/white/green roof studies;
 - viii) Low impact development (LID) engineering and design studies;
 - ix) Traffic impact assessments/studies;
 - x) Studies of microclimatic conditions (sun, shadow, wind);
 - xi) On-farm bio-digester feasibility and design studies;
 - xii) Phase Two environmental site assessments (ESA);
 - xiii) Designated substance and hazardous materials surveys;
 - xiv) Remedial work plans;
 - xv) Risk assessment/risk management plans;
 - xvi) Other site-specific studies which may be required by the Local Municipality or County at the time of pre-consultation or site plan approval

Minor Activity Grant

- 50% of eligible project costs up to a maximum of \$20,000
- Eligible projects may include:
 - Improvement/expansion projects
 - Creation housing units
 - Agricultural project
 - Green infrastructure
 - Tourism projects



Major Activity Grant

Annual grant to cover portion of the incremental tax increase following a project






Westario Power Overview

- Local Distribution Company (LDC) servicing 25,000 customers across 15 rural towns
- Comprised of 40 employees





- Westario Power has 27 Distribution Substations with 29 Station Transformers and 1 Mobile Station
- Westario Power is directly fed from Hydro One Distribution Substations in 5 of our towns
- New Distribution Substation under construction in Walkerton



Westario Power has approximately:

- 10,500 Poles
- 170km of Underground Distribution Primary
- 300km of Overhead Distribution Primary

The OFA is a producer-led organization that works to represent and champion the diverse interests of Ontario's agri-food sector and rural communities. Our work includes government relations, farm policy development, research, lobby efforts, community representation, media relations and more. We have a strong voice for our members and the agri-food industry on issues, legislation and regulations governed by municipal, provincial and federal governments.

We are the leading agricultural advocate for Ontario farmers, their farm businesses and their communities.

Our Members

- A Member of WFA shall be any Registered Farm Business with membership with OFA or anyone with an Individual Farm Membership with OFA, who resides in the County and the City of Guelph.
- Members of WFA shall have the right to attend and vote at all WFA General Meetings and to seek election to the WFA Board of Directors.
- Only one person per membership is permitted to cast a vote during a voting process.




